Nifty Nature

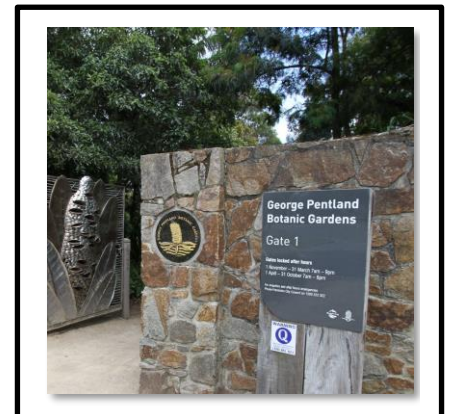
We have started looking at our Unit of Inquiry for this term, Biological Science. We have been exploring living and non-living things.
